Introduction to GIS Mapping

Description: The training session will teach participants how to carry out basic GIS mapping combining physical and social data. The session will examine the basics of mapping via satellite based remote sensing techniques, provide practice on how to classify and fetch data on the landuse and land cover, and examine GIS database creation and mapping. The session will consist of both theoretical and hands on practice using open source software, and the examples used in the workshop will focus on water security data and WASH issues.
