## Pre-Arrival Learning

#### Utilising Online Technologies and Resources whilst studying at Kent:

The University has launched the **Online Learning at Kent** <u>Moodle</u> module for all students. This includes information and tutorials on the key IT systems used by the University. You can access and complete this at your convenience **once you are fully registered online and have your Kent username and password set up.** It is advisable that you do this as soon as you can to support your learning.

## SkillBuilder videos to refresh your academic skills and baseline maths skills for your studies at Kent:

The Student Learning Advisory Service (SLAS) offers a range of SkillBuilder videos to support student's studies. #### <u>Welcome Week</u> <u>Postgraduate Student Induction</u>


