### Archival illustrations:

A note on the reproduction of archival drawings

This book is as much about the actual drawings found in diocesan collections as it is about their content and for that reason it has been important to reproduce them faithfully and without succumbing to the temptation of improving their clarity through digital manipulation. In most cases the drawings were photographed or scanned directly from the original; with others, there was necessarily an intermediate printed stage. These reproductions, however they are achieved, inevitably give a slightly distorted appearance to an image: a fold or crease in the paper, for example, will be much more prominent in the reproduction than it appears when looking at the original document itself; and the contrast between line and background appears less marked in a reproduction than it is in reality. Distortions such as these, arising from the reproduction process itself, have been therefore reduced as far as is reasonable. The rule of thumb in any case has been that the reproduction on the page should resemble the original item as much as possible. All the work of preparing images for publication from digital files received from archives and from my original drawings was done professionally by Assaf Krebs. I am also very grateful to Sarah Franklin of the Architectural Association Photo Library for help with the transfer of images.
