Anything in the realm of early modern cultural history and material culture, but specifically things to do with everyday beliefs and Central-Eastern Europe.

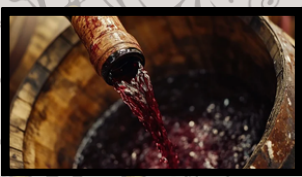
She likes strong tea with no sugar, dislikes the slimy feel of swimming pool changing room floors, and her hobbies include going for walks and playing the piano.
