Are you considering applying to university?

Do you want to study locally and are you interested in courses available at Kent?

If you answered yes, then Ambition to Succeed could be right for you! This free programme, delivered by our friendly team of staff and student ambassadors, is designed to help young people from Kent and Medway explore both the academic and social side of university life. You will be encouraged to analyse your own interests, strengths and ambitions, and you will have the opportunity to gain in-depth experience of Kent subjects that interest you.

What does the programme entail?

The course in year 1 involves a programme of online sessions and campus visits, from March to August. These activities take you through the key stages of university life and will help you decide what you might want from your own university experience. You will be supported to build your confidence and knowledge around higher education, enhance your communication and academic skills, and develop a clear understanding of the subject(s) you want to apply for. In August, we will invite you for an immersive residential experience on our Canterbury campus, to build knowledge, friendships and memories!

Year 2 support

In year 2, we will continue to support your application journey, with a series of livestream drop-in and group support sessions at key points in the application cycle. We will be there to help you all the way through your journey to university!

Ambition to Succeed Scholarship and Scholars Programme

On successful completion of the programme and if you are accepted onto a course at Kent, you will be eligible for our Ambition to Succeed scholarship package. See our website for more information.

When you enrol with us, you will also be invited to join the Kent Ambition Scholars Programme, an enrichment programme designed to enhance your academic, employability and personal development skills, including an invitation to apply to our Student Ambassador Scheme. Who can apply?

We encourage all interested Year 12 or first year FE level 3 (T Level or BTEC) students to apply, who meet one or more of the following criteria:

- They live in an area of low participation in Higher Education
- They have achieved five GCSEs 9-4, including Maths and English
- Their parent(s)/guardian(s) did not attend university
- They have been in receipt of Free School Meals (FSM)
- They are from a group which is under-represented in Higher Education, including:
 - Live in or have lived in local authority care
 - Refugees or unaccompanied asylum-seeking children
 - Disabled students
 - Young carers
 - Those studying without the support of family/carers
 - Gypsy, traveller, roma, showmen and boater.

- Staff and student ambassadors will support you to explore the courses available at the University of Kent
- You'll gain first-hand experience of a university campus and all its facilities
- You will experience what it feels like to be a student
