General

Purpose built and located on the University Campus

Disabled access to the studio space.

Technical

White box studio space

Flexible rostra seating for 60 on chairs (see separate sheet for configurations)

Partition wall which divides the spaces can be opened to create one full area.

Rigged area 10.5m x 9.0 m

Unrigged area 7m x 9.0m

Total studio area 18m x 9m

Floor covered in Lino on a concrete base (white/grey)

Height of fixed scaffolding grid is 4.52m

Soft black masking on T60 track all around rigged area.

Height of curtain track is 4.52m

Get in via rigged or unrigged double height dock doors

LX and Sound can be operated together in the control room access via dimmer room ladder Access to the grid is by Scaffold Tower

We regret that there are no shower facilities or dressing rooms in this studio.

Lighting

Standard rig is hung to allow the performer/audience to be positioned from any side with front/back and side light comprising of;

Warm Wash 12 x 500w Fresnel on LEE103

Cold Wash 12 x 500w Fresnel on LEE 202
