

## **Art Opening Minds: Perspectives and Imagination in Film**

### **Recruitment of participants**

**What is the aim of this study?** This study aims to examine perspective-taking and imagination outcomes in university students after having watched a film to better understand the process of imagination.

**What do participants have to do during the experiment?** They will need to complete online survey items and watch a film in a quiet booth by themselves for the duration of the study. Some electrodes will be applied on the skin to measure electrodermal activity and heart rate. These measures are completely safe and non-invasive.

**Duration?** 2 hours

**Payment?** 15 pounds

**Where?** School of Psychology, Keynes College, University of Kent, Canterbury, CT2 7NP

**Who can take part in the experiment?**

**Participant must be:**

- fluent in English
- Over 18 years of age

**Participants CANNOT take part if:**

- They have a diagnosis of Autism Spectrum Disorder (ASD)
- Have seen the film to be watched, 'Jackie Brown', prior to the study
